## Setting up Vodafone GPRS, WAP and MMS on a Pocket PC device

This article applies to the Pocket PC 2003 and Windows Mobile 5.0 platforms

## Setting up the GPRS connection

Tap on Start and select Settings Tap on the Connections tab at the bottom of the screen Tap on the Connections icon In the My ISP section, tap on the option to Add a new modem connection In the Name field, type in Vodafone GPRS In the Modem field, select Cellular Line (GPRS) Tap Next In the Access Point Name field, type in internet Tap Next Type in web for both user name and password. Leave the Domain field blank Tap Finish

## Setting up the WAP connection

Tap on Start and select Settings Tap on the **Connections** tab at the bottom of the screen Tap on the **Connections** icon In the Mv Work Network section, tap on the option to Add a new modem connection In the Name field, type in Vodafone WAP In the Modem field, select Cellular Line (GPRS) Tap Next In the Access Point Name field, type in wap.vodafone.co.uk Tap Next Type in wap for both user name and password. Leave the **Domain** field blank Tap **Finish** In the My Work Network section, tap on the option to Manage existing connections Tap on the **Proxv Settings** tab at the bottom of the screen Tick the option This network connects to the Internet Tick the option **This network uses a proxy server to connect to the Internet** Tap on the **Advanced** button Tap on the entry for WAP In the Server field enter 212.183.137.012 In the Port field enter 8799 Leave the User Name, Password and Domain fields blank. Tap **OK** 3 times to save the settings

## Setting up the MMS account

Tap on Start and select Messaging Tap on the Menu button and select MMS Configuration On the Preferences tab, scroll down to Photo Resolution. Set the option to VGA (640x480) Tap on the Servers tab at the bottom of the screen Tap on the New button In the Server Name field enter Vodafone MMS In the Gateway field enter 212.183.137.012 In the Port Number field enter 9201 In the Server Address field enter http://mms.vodafone.co.uk/servlets/mms/ In the Connect Via field, select My Work Network Set the Sending size limitation to 250K Set the WAP Version to WAP 1.2 Tap OK Tap the Set As Default button Tap OK

Your device has now been configured.
