Setting up Three Internet and MMS on a Pocket PC device

This article applies to the Pocket PC 2003 and Windows Mobile 5.0 platforms

Setting up the Internet connection

Tap on Start and select Settings

Tap on the **Connections** tab at the bottom of the screen

Tap on the **Connections** icon

In the My ISP section, tap on the option to Add a new modem connection

In the Name field, type in Three 3G

In the Modem field, select Cellular Line (GPRS,3G)

Tap **Next**

In the Access Point Name field, type in three.co.uk

Tap **Next**

Leave the Username. Password and Domain fields blank

Tap **Finish**

Setting up the MMS connection

Tap on Start and select Settings

Tap on the **Connections** tab at the bottom of the screen

Tap on the **Connections** icon

In the Mv Work Network section, tap on the option to Add a new modem connection

In the Name field, type in Three MMS

In the Modem field, select Cellular Line (GPRS,3G)

Tap Next

In the Access Point Name field, type in three.co.uk

Tap **Next**

Leave the **Username**, **Password** and **Domain** fields blank

Tap **Finish**

In the My Work Network section, tap on the option to Manage existing connections

Tap on the **Proxy Settings** tab at the bottom of the screen

Tick the option **This network connects to the Internet**

Tick the option This network uses a proxy server to connect to the Internet

Tap on the **Advanced** button

Tap on the entry for WAP

In the Server field enter 217.171.129.002

In the Port field enter 8799

Leave the User Name, Password and Domain fields blank.

Tap **OK** 3 times to save the settings

Setting up the MMS account

Tap on Start and select Messaging

Tap on the Menu button and select MMS Configuration

On the Preferences tab, scroll down to Photo Resolution. Set the option to VGA (640x480)

Tap on the **Servers** tab at the bottom of the screen

Tap on the **New** button

In the Server Name field enter Three MMS

In the Gateway field enter 217.171.129.002

In the Port Number field enter 9201

In the Server Address field enter http://mms.um.three.co.uk:10021/mmsc

In the Connect Via field, select Three MMS
Set the Sending size limitation to 250K
Set the WAP Version to WAP 1.2
Tap OK
Tap the Set As Default button
Tap OK

Your device has now been configured.
