Using a Windows Mobile 5 device as a USB modem

NOTE – Before you connect your PDA to your PC you must install ActiveSync, which will be found on the Companion CD which came with your device. Once ActiveSync has been installed, connect your PDA to your PC via the USB cable and follow the New Partnership wizard.

Installing the Modem

Insert the Companion CD for your PDA into the PC. Close any software that autoruns. Connect your PDA to the USB port of your PC. Launch ActiveSync. Open the **File** menu and select **Connection Settings**:

On the PDA, tap Start and then Programs.

Tap on Internet Sharing (for older devices, select Wireless Modem)

Select USB as the connection method

Select which Internet connection on the PDA you wish to use

Tap Connect

Your PC will detect new hardware automatically and launch the New Hardware Wizard:



Select the option to Install from a specific location and click Next



Select the option Don't search. I will choose the driver to install and click Next

Click on the Have Disk button. Browse to the CD and select the driver file 'USBMDM.INF' and click OK
